When I just hit submit button, I receive such error in console: SQLSTATE[23000]: Integrity constraint violation: 1048 Column 'id' cannot be null (SQL: update `posts` set `title` =, `description` =, `created_at` =, `updated_at` = 2018-11-29 22:44:06.737766 for article 6-default) I have tried to add 'id' => 0 in my \$attributes array, and then 'id' => null in update function. I think, my issue is not related to 'id', but rather to update() function in Post model, but I dont know how to fix this. A: It was a permission error.
